

EvalGender+ call for proposals

EvalGender+ is launching a call for proposals to provide seed funding for current or upcoming knowledge generation connected to equity-focused and gender responsive (EFGR) evaluations. The proposed funding is to be used in 2020 and consists of <u>4 grants of USD 2,000 each</u>.

The main objective is to identify and foster innovation for knowledge generation that can be used to advocate for more EFGR evaluation in the context of the SDGs, to enrich evaluation field and enhance the role of evidence in promoting gender equality and equity.

This call for proposals intends to leverage recently launched call for proposals for <u>gLOCAL Evaluation</u> <u>Week</u>, to be held June 1-5, 2020 (current deadline for proposals is March 24, 2020). gLOCAL Evaluation Week intends to support local and global M&E knowledge sharing and networking, promote evaluation practice, and support evidence-based policy making. Events can take place anywhere around the world, in any language.

EG+ will support selected submitters and winners by:

- Publicizing winners and connecting with submitters from the same countries and regions,
- EG+ will provide EG+ brochure to associate with the presentation at the gLOCAL Evaluation Week.
- The four (4) winners will be able to present at a Webinar with one of the EG+ Management Group members and/or UN Women representative
- EG+ will potentially facilitate publication of a brief in an evaluation-related modality
- Final winner receives 1 award for travel to an international conference or Global Evaluation Forum.

The main criteria for selection of proposals by EG+MG would include:

- Innovation: proposals should bring a new lens to EFGR evaluation for SDGs, in the spirit of "Evidence Matters".
- Link to EvalGender+ mission.
- Quality: the proposal should be based on existing evidence, and provide a clear roadmap for use of the results.
- Non-previous exposure: the presenter should not have had the possibility to present this work in conferences yet.
- Submission should be in English

Considerations

- Eligibility: Individuals representing a Voluntary Organization for Professional Evaluation
- Grant: The grant can be used towards research and data collection (survey, paper, etc) including planning a roundtable or presentation at gLocalweek (cost of travel and accommodation).



- Proposal should be submitted in English, while related activity during gLOCAL event can be in any language.
- Deadline for submission: 15 April 2020.
